



Chura Size Guide

This guide is to help you determine the correct size and perfect fit for your slip on Chura. Here we will describe two ways to find your Indian bangle size use during your shopping experience with us; Measuring your hand and/or Measuring an existing bangle you own.

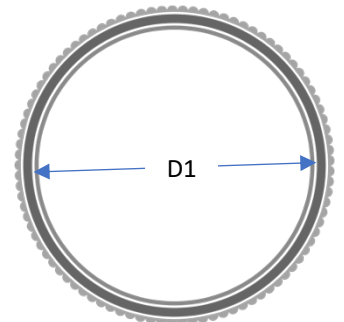
Measuring your hand

Bring your thumb and little finger together and wrap a flexible tape measure around the widest part of your palm (usually the knuckles and thumb) as shown in Fig 1.

The measurement where the tape measure overlaps is your hand circumference measurement. Use this measurement in the table below to determine your Indian bangle size.

Measuring an existing bangle

Place your bangle on a flat surface. Take a ruler and measure the inner diameter of the bangle from the inner tips on both sides as shown in Fig 2. Use this measurement in the table below to determine your Indian bangle size.
